Make checks payable to Beeville Art Museum and mail, along with completed forms, to 401 E. Fannin, Beeville, TX 78102.
2. All vendors will be provided a 10' x 10' space at no additional charge.
3. Although, no tents, tables or other equipment will be provided, you are encouraged to bring your own that fits within your allotted space.
4. Final set-up and placement will be communicated 1 week prior to the festival.
5. Internet connections will not be provided; be prepared to provide a hotspot for your personal use, should you need one.
6. Non-profit groups ONLY are allowed to sell food and beverage items. Please provide a description above of what you will be selling to insure that we have appropriate diversity of offerings.
7. For Profit vendors need to provide photo sample or website address for review of their art work.
8. Content should not include nudity, political statements, profanity or other such depictions that may be considered offensive. This is a family-friendly event.
9. Plan on sharing information about the event on your preferred social media platform. BEE•FEST requests a total of 5 social media posts prior to the event. Please tag the Beeville Art Museum (not Beeville Art) and use the hashtag #beevillebeefest.
10. In case inclement weather warrants cancellation, we will attempt to contact you by phone and email. We will also post notifications on the Beeville Art Museum Facebook page and the BeeFest website.
